This suit coming on this day for hearing before this Court in the presence of the counsel for the parties as aforesaid, and upon the parties having agreed to settle the matter, it is ordered that a decree of permanent injunction be and the same is hereby passed in favour of the plaintiff and against the defendants restraining the defendants, their members, associates and office bearers from preventing ingress and egress of the staff and willing workers, disrupting the functioning of the plaintiff in any manner or using abusive slogans.
