3.	Can a student in final year of essential qualification degree apply.	No, the result should have been declared on or before 01.09.2015 . Proper document from Board / University for having declared the result on or before 01.09.2015 has to be submitted at the time of interview.
4.	Can candidates of Production & Industrial Engineering discipline apply for Mechanical Engineering.	No, the present requirement is in Mechanical Engineering only.
5.	Can a candidate of Mechanical & Automation Engineering discipline apply for Mechanical Engineering.	Yes, candidates of Mechanical & Automation Engineering Discipline may apply for Mechanical Engineering.
6.	Can a candidate of Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering discipline apply for Electronics Engineering.	Yes, candidates of Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering discipline may apply for Electronics Engineering.
7.	Can candidates of Electrical & Electronics Engineering Discipline apply for both Electrical Engineering and Electronics Engineering.	No, candidates of Electrical & Electronics Engineering Discipline may apply either for Electrical Engineering or Electronics Engineering. Such candidates are advised to exercise option carefully and no change in the discipline once opted will be allowed subsequently.
8.	Can candidates with 59.9 % marks (49.9% marks for SC/ST candidates) in Bachelors degree of Engineering apply.	No, the qualification requirement is "Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or Technology or equivalent with not less than 60% marks in aggregate (50% for SC/ST candidates)". The fraction of percentage will be ignored i.e. 59.99% will be treated as less than 60% and 49.99% will be treated as less than 50%.
9.	What is the age limit and what is the cut-off date for age limit.	The candidates must be between 21-30 years of age as on 01.09.2015 .

10.	What relaxations in upper age limit are applicable and to which category of candidates.	Relaxation in upper age limit are applicable for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/Ex-Servicemen/ Persons who had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of J&K during the period from 1st January, 1980 to 31st December, 1989.
