



Workshop on Preparing for National Quality Awards (11-12 February 2010)

NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF TRAINING FOR STANDARDIZATION (NITS)

Bureau of Indian Standards (**BIS**), the National Standards Body of India, has been providing various services to the Industry through its activities of Standardization, Product Certification, Management Systems Certification and Training. For meeting the training needs of the Manufacturing and Services Sectors and the Government, BIS has set up a National Institute of Training for Standardization (**NITS**) at NOIDA.

Objective

Considering that the criteria under the RGNQA covers a wide range of organizational activities, a need has been expressed for acquainting and training the potential applicants for making adequate preparations at their end before they apply for the award. To meet this demand, A workshop is being organized by NITS at Noida. The current programme is of two days duration intended to guide the participants for preparing for **Rajiv Gandhi National Quality Award (RGNQA) 2009**. The programme will be held during **11-12 February 2010** from **0900 to 1730 h** at **NITS, NOIDA**.

Who should attend?

The organizations who want to compete for Rajiv Gandhi National Quality Award or interested in sharing their experience with award winners will greatly benefit from this workshop. It is hoped that this workshop will not only help the organizations to assess their strengths and weaknesses, but may also find solutions to improve them.

Scope of the Programme

The Workshop will facilitate:

- Understanding of various facets of RGNQA including eligibility criteria,
- Understanding of Assessment Process and its criteria,
- Guidance on preparing for the awards,
- Preparation of documentation involved in the application process for RGNQA,
- Case Studies of previous awardees of RGNQA, and
- Benefits of RGNQA for Applicants and Winners.

The Workshop will be addressed by award winners of Rajiv Gandhi National Quality Award and BIS officers/assessors.

Course Fee

The course fee for participation is Rs. 5,000.00 per participant. In addition, service tax @10.3% shall also be applicable. Thus, the total course fee applicable shall be **Rs. 5,515/=**. In case, the hostel facility at NITS, NOIDA is to be availed (AC room on single occupancy basis in a double bedded room with complimentary breakfast, tea/coffee and dinner), an additional amount of Rs. 750/= +10.3% Service Tax per night per participant shall be charged.

Nominations

Nomination form can be downloaded from our website at www.bis.org.in or nomination can be sent on organizations Letter Head. Maximum number of participants will be twenty (25). Seats will be offered on First-come-First-registered (with payment) basis. Nominations should reach Head (NITS) at the earliest but positively, one week before the commencement of the programme along with the Demand Draft for the course fee, which should be drawn in favour of Bureau of Indian Standards, New Delhi or NOIDA for the requisite amount.
