NATIONAL FOREWORD

This draft Indian Standard is proposed adoption of an ISO Technical Specification 22002-1:2009 ‘Prerequisite Programmes on Food Safety – Part 1: Food Manufacturing’. An ISO Technical Specification (ISO/TS) represents an agreement between the members of a technical committee and is accepted for publication if it is approved by 2/3 of the members of the committee casting a vote, whereas International Standard (ISO) requires approval by at least 3/4 of the member bodies casting a vote. An ISO/TS is reviewed after three years in order to decide whether it will be confirmed for a further three years, revised to become an International Standard, or withdrawn. If the ISO/TS is confirmed, it is reviewed again after a further three years, at which time it must either be transformed into an International Standard or be withdrawn.

The text of ISO/TS has been approved as suitable for publication as an Indian Standard without deviations. Certain conventions are, however, not identical to those used in Indian Standards. Attention is particularly drawn to the following:

- a) Wherever the words ‘International Standard’ appear referring to this standard, they should be read as ‘Indian Standard’.
- b) Comma(,) has been used as a decimal marker while in Indian Standards, the current practice is to use a point (.) as the decimal marker.

In this adopted standard, reference appears to certain International Standards for which Indian Standards also exist. The corresponding Indian Standards which are to be substituted in their respective places are listed below along with their degree of equivalence for the editions indicated:

Nothing in this Indian Standard shall affect the operation of the *Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006* and regulations framed thereunder; *Standards of Weights and Measures Act, 1977* or any other law for the time being in force and shall be subject to the restrictions imposed thereunder, wherever applicable.

In reporting the result of a test or analysis made in accordance with this standard, if the final value, observed or calculated, is to be rounded off, it shall be done in accordance with IS 2:1960 'Rules for rounding off numerical values (*revised*)'.
