Subject: Amendment to policy for issue of 10 digit licence number

This is with reference to the circular of even number dated 20 10 2014 regarding introduction of 10 digit licence numbering system which was implemented w.e.f 01-12-2014.

Based on the difficulties expressed by BOs and licensees matter was examined by CMDIII(CA&M) and it has been decided that provision of prefixing three zeros "000" to the existing 7 digit licence number for aligning with the new practice stands withdrawn with immediate effect (refer clause 2(iii) and 4 of the above mentioned circular).

Seven digit licence numbers would continue as it is and BOs to continue to issue 10 digit licence numbers as per new policy implemented w.e.f. 01-12-2014. CMMS is capable of accepting 7 digit as well as 10 digit licence numbers.

It is clarified that wherever seven digit licence numbers have been revised to 10 digits by prefixing three zeros "000" shall be changed back to seven digit to maintain uniformity.
