Caves And Forts

The following caves and forts are worth seeing by every visitors. Every one will be struck with ancient sculptures.

<u>Karla Caves</u>	12 km from Lonavala Railway Station.
<u>Bhaja Caves</u>	14 km from Lonavala Railway Station
<u>Bedsa Caves</u>	21 km from Lonavala Railway Station
<u>Visapur Fort</u>	14 km from Lonavala Railway Station
<u>Lohgad Fort</u>	14 km from Lonavala Railway Station
<u>Rajmachi Fort</u>	20 km from Lonavala Railway Station
<u>Korigad Fort</u>	20 km from Lonavala Railway Station

Lakes and Dams :

Lonavala is famous for dams in its vicinity. The majority of them supply water for generating electricity at Khopoli Power House.

<u>Lonavala Dam & Lake</u>	Approx. 2.40 km. from Lonavala
<u>Bushi Dam & Lake</u>	Approx. 6.00 km. from Lonavala
<u>Tungarli Dam & Lake</u>	Approx. 3.00 km. from Lonavala
<u>Valvan Dam & Lake</u>	Approx. 3.00 km. from Lonavala
<u>Shirota Dam & Lake</u>	Approx. 11.00 km. from Lonavala
<u>Pavna Dam & Lake</u>	Approx. 32.00 km. from Lonavala

Bairamaji Point : It is 8 km from Khandala Station

Reversing Point : It is near Rajmachi Point, Khandala 8 km from Lonavala. It is known for the panoramic view and the Duke’s nose on the other.

Kune Point : Midway to Lonavala and Khandala on the highway. It is known for its scenic beauty.

Barometer Hills : It is 24 km. from Lonavala Railway Station with Tungi and Koregad Fort is an extensive table and called Sakur Pather, famous for healthy climate.

Dukes Nose : It is in Khandala about 12 km. from Lonavala. The summit of a hill so named owing to its resemblance of nose of Duke. The Duke of Wellington good for Hiking.

Ray wood Park : A densely wooded park in the vicinity of Lonavala.

I.N.S. Shivaji : This is a base naval Camp.

Kaivalyadham : It is 2.12 km. from Lonavala.

Tata Duct Line : It is 3 km. Khandala Railway Station.

4. This property is Duplex Apartment located at Lonavala (Near Narayani Dham) approximately 1 to 1.5 km. From on Old Mumbai – Pune highway at a walkable distance from Kailash Parbat Hotel, Lonavala.
5. It is a self contained property within a residential complex and consist of 2 Bedrooms, Living Room and a kitchen. A big garden sit out is also available. Swimming pool is also there in society complex.
6. It has been desired by CA that we have been able to procure the facilities with clear understanding that since it is within residential complex, absolute decency shall be maintained by the occupants. It is therefore, requested that users of the Holiday Home shall take care to see that complete decency is maintained at all times and nothing is allowed to happen that may adversely affect our reputation.
7. The facilities are ideal for 6 persons maximum at a time. In addition to kitchen facility available within the premises, home made food can be provided from a nearby household/Jain derasar.
8. A caretaker has also been appointed who will be available as & when required.
9. Request for Reservation may be sent to Section office, Administration Department, WRO, Mumbai directly. (Phone No. 022-28253430, Email – adminwro@bis.org.in, Application for accommodation has to be submitted at least one week in advance. Persons other than mentioned in the booking memo will not be allowed to stay in the allotted rooms. The concerned allottee shall carry I- Card and produce Allotment Letter accordingly.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. The allottee should carry the Allotment Letter and his/her Identity Card. The Caretaker would not allow entry without the Allotment Letter and identity Card.
2. The allottee should mention their contact no. in the application form itself.
3. The number of persons mentioned in the Allotment Letter should not exceed in any case, 6 person(s) maximum. Other than those mentioned in the Allotment Letter would not be allowed to occupy the room.
4. The allottee should take care not to damage any of the furniture items and other equipments provided in the Holiday home.
5. Allotment would be done either from the forenoon or afternoon of a particular day. Forenoon would mean upto 1200 h. Those allotted a Booking in the afternoon would be given entry after 1200 h only. Similarly, those allotted a Booking upto the forenoon of a particular day have to vacate the Holiday Home at 1200 h on that day.
6. Accommodation once reserved, can be cancelled only if a clear 7 days notice is received from the allottee. In case of a notice of shorter period, cancellation can be done only if there is demand for the rooms from some other employee to whom it can be allotted. Otherwise, the original allottee would have to bear the full charges for the reservation.
7. Allottee should maintain Decency and decorum.
8. Allottee should avoid any Nuisance in Holiday Home.
9. It has been desired by CA that we have been able to procure the facilities with clear understanding that since it is within residential complex, absolute decency shall be maintained by the occupants.
